No.Fest is Friday June 25, 7-11pm and Saturday the 26th, 10am-12am.

InterArts' 3rd Annual No.Fest has grown again, no longer just "nu.music" or experimental, No.Fest is for everyone, all ages, free to the public. Friday, June 25th kicks off with a **"Bangin! International Urban Folk Dance"** in historic St. Johns Town Square, featuring **The Incredible Kid** from 7-10pm. Plus an Art Walk with 10 exhibitions spanning 7 galleries, as well as surprise locations throughout St. Johns.

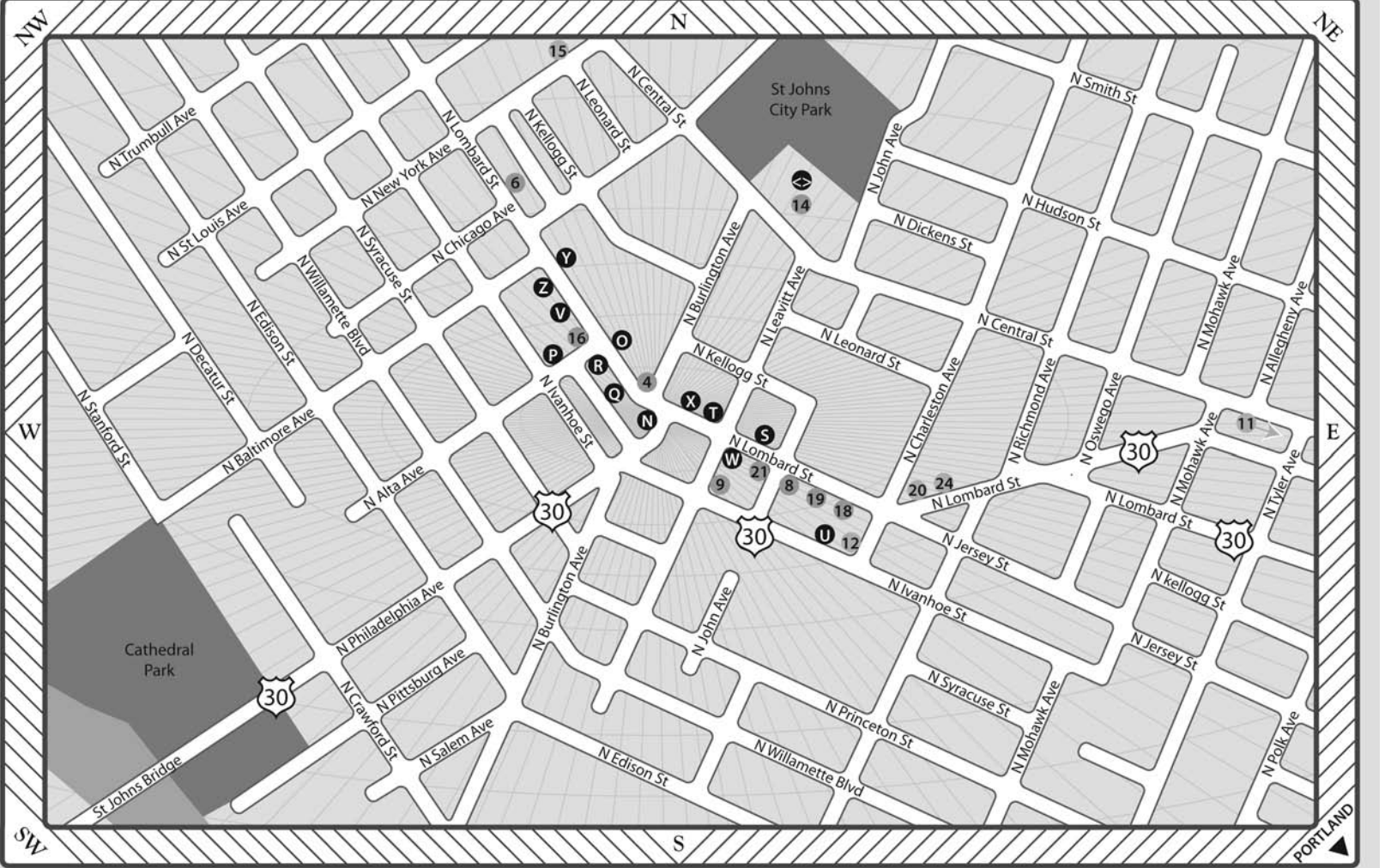


